THE HOLY ROSARY

The Rosary is an ancient prayer that helps us contemplate the love of God through Christ Jesus. It is a prayer of meditation that makes you contemplate Jesus' incarnation and birth, ministry, passion and death, and finally, His resurrection. It's the entire story of salvation on a set of 59 beads that can help us contemplate every single day the wonderful savior He is in our lives and in our world.

The main prayers of the rosary are the "Our Father" (the prayer Jesus taught us in the Gospel), and the "Hail Mary" (the words of the angel and of Elizabeth as written in Luke chapter 1). The rosary has been a principal devotion of the faithful and has been in use all through the centuries, from the time of the apostles and disciples down to the present, although it has changed in form many times over the years.

HOW TO PRAY THE ROSARY

The rosary is a daily devotion that can be prayed throughout the day or all at once. There are 20 mysteries in all, and they are broken into four sets: Joyful Mysteries, Luminous Mysteries, Sorrowful Mysteries, and Glorious Mysteries. Typically the Joyful Mysteries are said on Mondays and Saturdays, the Luminous Mysteries are said on Thursdays, the Sorrowful Mysteries are said on Tuesdays and Fridays, and the Glorious Mysteries are said on Wednesdays and Sundays. Some people pray the whole rosary every day, and break it up into 4 separate prayers, morning, noon, evening, and night. The entire rosary can be said in 15-20 minutes, and while one is praying the Hail Mary prayers they should be contemplating the mystery that they are on. You can do this by envisioning the scene in your mind.

THE HOLY ROSARY

BENEFITS OF THE ROSARY

The rosary is a wonderful prayer for growing in virtue and holiness and for praying with your family. It is meant to be prayed as a group but can also be prayed alone. It is an effective prayer for protection against evil, which is why this devotion is strongly embraced by the pro-life movement. Once you become familiar with it, this becomes a prayer that you can pray anywhere and anytime. It will increase your faith, strengthen your love of God, and help you grow in virtue.

INTRODUCTION

The prayers of the rosary are a scriptural walk through the life of Jesus as seen by Mary His mother. It is a meditation and should be prayed slowly while envisioning each mystery in the life of Jesus. The rosary begins on the crucifix and moves along the 59 beads. The first prayers are the “Apostles Creed” the “Our Father” and three “Hail Marys” which are prayed for an increase in FAITH, HOPE, and LOVE.

THE MYSTERIES

The big beads begin with one of 5 mysteries on the life of Jesus and after the mystery an “Our Father” is prayed on that bead. The small beads are “Hail Mary” prayers. After the 10th “Hail Mary” we recite the “Glory Be” prayer and the “Fatima” prayer, which were later added and do not have a bead, so we keep our fingers on the chain before the next “Our Father” bead.

THE CLOSING PRAYERS

We end the rosary with “Hail Holy Queen” and the “Rosary Prayer”.

APOSTLE'S CREED:

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; he descended into hell; on the third day he rose again from the dead; he ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there he will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

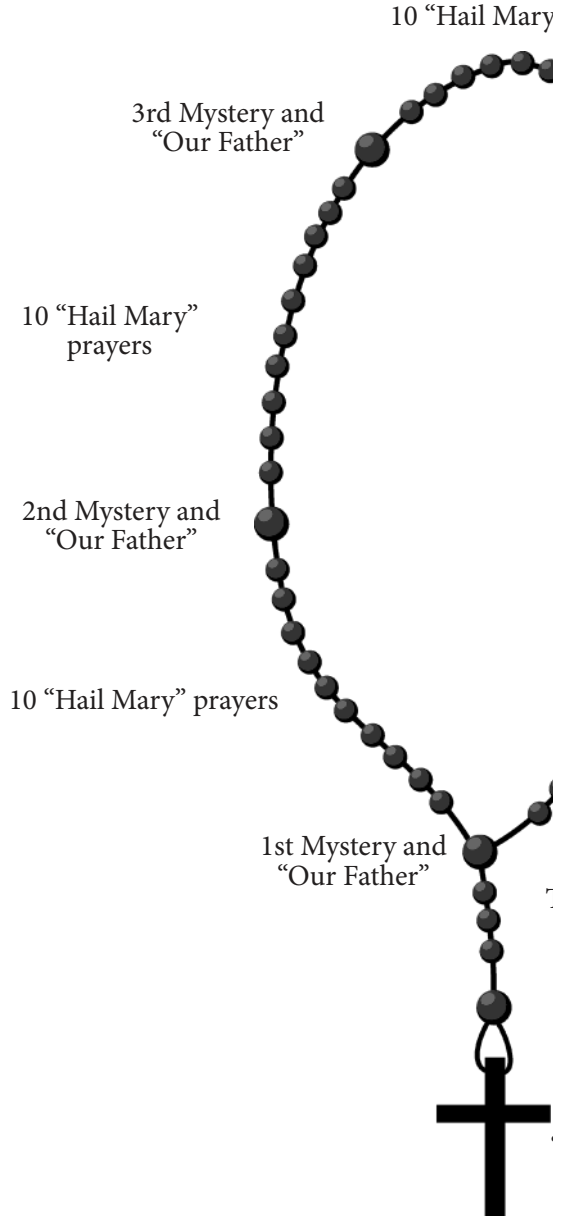
OUR FATHER:

HAIL MARY:

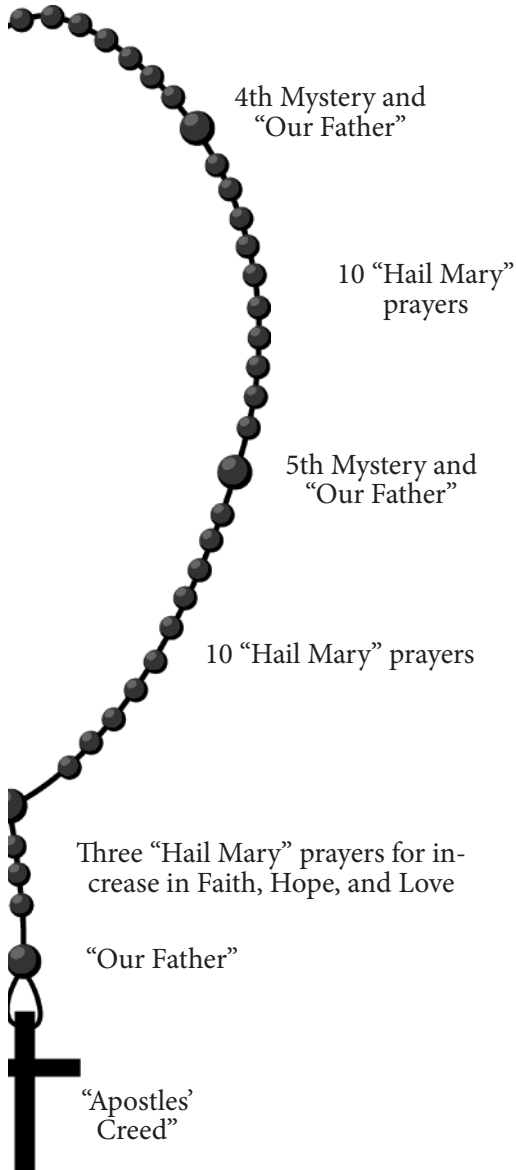

THE FIRST JOYFUL MYSTERY

We offer you, O Lord Jesus, this first decade in honor of The Annunciation, and we ask you through this mystery and through the intercession of your holy Mother, the gift of humility. May the Holy Spirit give us wisdom and understanding to dominate our passions and overcome our pride. The Gospel according to Luke chapter 1 verse 28 “And when the angel had come to her, he said, “Hail, full of grace, the Lord is with you.”

THE SECOND JOYFUL MYSTERY

We offer you, O Lord Jesus, this second decade in honor of The Visitation, and we ask you through this mystery and through the intercession of your holy Mother, the gift of love of neighbor. May the Holy Spirit give us the knowledge to understand the ways of God through being a good neighbor to all, even those who persecute us. The Gospel according to Luke chapter 1 verses 41 and 42 “Elizabeth, filled with the Holy Spirit, cried out in a loud voice and said, “Most blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb.”

THE THIRD JOYFUL MYSTERY

We offer you, O Lord Jesus, this third decade in honor of The Nativity, and we ask you through this mystery and through the intercession of your holy Mother, the gift of poverty in spirit. We offer you, O Lord Jesus, this fourth decade in honor of Your Presentation in the Temple, and we ask you through this mystery and through the intercession of your holy Mother, the gift of obedience to Your Holy Will. May the Holy Spirit give us a holy fear of disobeying God and sinning against Him. The Gospel according to Luke chapter 2 verses 22 and 23 “When the days were completed for their purification according to the law of Moses, they took Him up to Jerusalem to present Him to the Lord, just as it is written in the law of the Lord, “Every male that opens the womb shall be consecrated to the Lord.”

THE FIFTH JOYFUL MYSTERY

We offer you, O Lord Jesus, this Fifth decade in honor of Mary’s finding You in the Temple, and we ask you through this mystery and through the intercession of your holy Mother, the gift of spiritual joy. May the Holy Spirit give us the gift of fearlessness so that we have both joy and hope even in suffering. THE FIRST LUMINOUS MYSTERY

We offer you, O Lord Jesus, this first decade in honor of Your Baptism, and we ask you through this mystery and through the intercession of your holy Mother, the gift of openness to the Holy Spirit. May the Holy Spirit enlighten us to understand God's ways. The Gospel according to Matthew chapter 3 verses 16 and 17 "After Jesus was baptized... the heavens were opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming upon Him. And a voice came from the heavens, saying, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased."

THE SECOND LUMINOUS MYSTERY

We offer you, O Lord Jesus, this second decade in honor of The Wedding Feast at Cana, and we ask you through this mystery and through the intercession of your holy Mother, the gift of finding you, Jesus, through Mary our mother. May the Holy Spirit give us the knowledge of divine truth. The Gospel according to John chapter 2 verses 5 through 7 "His mother said to the servers, "Do whatever He tells you..." Jesus told them, "Fill the jars with water." So they filled them to the brim.

THE THIRD LUMINOUS MYSTERY

We offer you, O Lord Jesus, this third decade in honor of The Proclamation of the Kingdom of God, and we ask you through this mystery and through the intercession of your holy Mother, the gift of true repentance for our sins and a conversion of our hearts. May the Holy Spirit admonish us and reveal our sins. The Gospel according to Matthew chapter 10 verses 7 and 8 “As you go, make this proclamation: “The kingdom of heaven is at hand.” Cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, drive out demons. Without cost you have received; without cost you are to give.”

THE FOURTH LUMINOUS MYSTERY

We offer you, O Lord Jesus, this fourth decade in honor of The Transfiguration, and we ask you through this mystery and through the intercession of your holy Mother, the gift of desiring holiness. May the Holy Spirit strengthen our sanctity. The Gospel according to Luke chapter 9 verse 29 and 35 “While he was praying His face changed in appearance and his clothing became dazzling white. Then from the cloud came a voice that said, “This is My chosen Son; listen to Him.”

THE FIFTH LUMINOUS MYSTERY

We offer you, O Lord Jesus, this fifth decade in honor of The Institution of the Eucharist, and we ask you through this mystery and through the intercession of your holy Mother, the gift of love and adoration for the Eucharist. May the Holy Spirit give us a fear of offending God. The Gospel according to Luke chapter 22 verses 19 and 20 “Then He took the bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them, saying, “This is My body, which will be given for you...” And likewise the cup after they had eaten, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in My blood.”

THE FIRST SORROWFUL MYSTERY

We offer you, O Lord Jesus, this first decade in honor of The Agony in the Garden, and we ask you through this mystery and through the intercession of your holy Mother, the gift of humbly accepting God's will. May the Holy Spirit strengthen our understanding. The Gospel according to Luke chapter 22 verses 44 and 45 "He was in such agony and He prayed so fervently that His sweat became like drops of blood falling on the ground. When He rose from prayer and returned to His disciples, He found them sleeping from grief."

THE SECOND SORROWFUL MYSTERY

We offer you, O Lord Jesus, this second decade in honor of The Scourging at the Pillar, and we ask you through this mystery and through the intercession of your holy Mother, the gift of purity in our bodies, minds, and spirits. May the Holy Spirit strengthen our zeal for chastity, help us grow in wisdom, and increase our love for others. The Gospel according to Luke chapter 23 verses 14 through 16 [Pilate said:] "I have conducted my investigation in your presence and have not found this man guilty of the charges you have brought against Him, nor did Herod, for he sent him back to us. So no capital crime has been committed by Him. Therefore I shall have Him flogged and then release Him."

THE THIRD SORROWFUL MYSTERY

We offer you, O Lord Jesus, this third decade in honor of The Crowning with Thorns, and we ask you through this mystery and through the intercession of your holy Mother, the gift of courage and self-control. May the Holy Spirit help us persevere when we are weak. The Gospel according to John chapter 19 verses 2 and 3 “And the soldiers wove a crown out of thorns and placed it on His head, and clothed Him in a purple cloak, and they came to Him and said, “Hail, King of the Jews!” And they struck Him repeatedly.”

THE FOURTH SORROWFUL MYSTERY

We offer you, O Lord Jesus, this fourth decade in honor of The Carrying of Your Cross, and we ask you through this mystery and through the intercession of your holy Mother, the gift of patience amid suffering and persecution. May the Holy Spirit give us holy love for others even in the face of evil. The Gospel according to Luke chapter 23 verse 26 “As they led Him away they took hold of a certain Simon, a Cyrenian, who was coming in from the country; and after laying the cross on him, they made him carry it behind Jesus.”

THE FIFTH SORROWFUL MYSTERY

We offer you, O Lord Jesus, this fifth decade in honor of Your Crucifixion and Death, and we ask you through this mystery and through the intercession of your holy Mother, the gift of perseverance. May the Holy Spirit strengthen our fortitude to overcome all obstacles preventing personal holiness. The Gospel according to John chapter 19 verses 28 through 30 “After this, Jesus knew that everything had now been completed and, so that the scripture should be completely fulfilled, he said: “I am thirsty.” A jar of sour wine stood there; so, putting a sponge soaked in the wine on a hyssop stick, they held it up to his mouth. After Jesus had taken the wine, He said, “It is fulfilled” and bowing His head, He gave up His spirit.”

May the Holy Spirit give us understanding of Your holy ways. The Gospel of Mark chapter 16 verse 6 “Do not be amazed! You seek Jesus of Nazareth, the crucified. He has been raised; He is not here. Behold the place where they laid Him.”

THE SECOND GLORIOUS MYSTERY

We offer you, O Lord Jesus, this second decade in honor of The Ascension, and we ask you through this mystery and through the intercession of your holy Mother, the gift of hope. May the Holy Spirit strengthen our willingness to follow Your good counsel in our lives. The Gospel according to Mark chapter 16 verses 19 and 20 “And so the Lord Jesus, after He had spoken to them, was taken up into heaven; there at the right hand of God He took his place, while they, going out, preached everywhere, the Lord working with them and confirming the word by the signs that accompanied it.”
