Pray the Prayers on the corresponding numbered Beads:

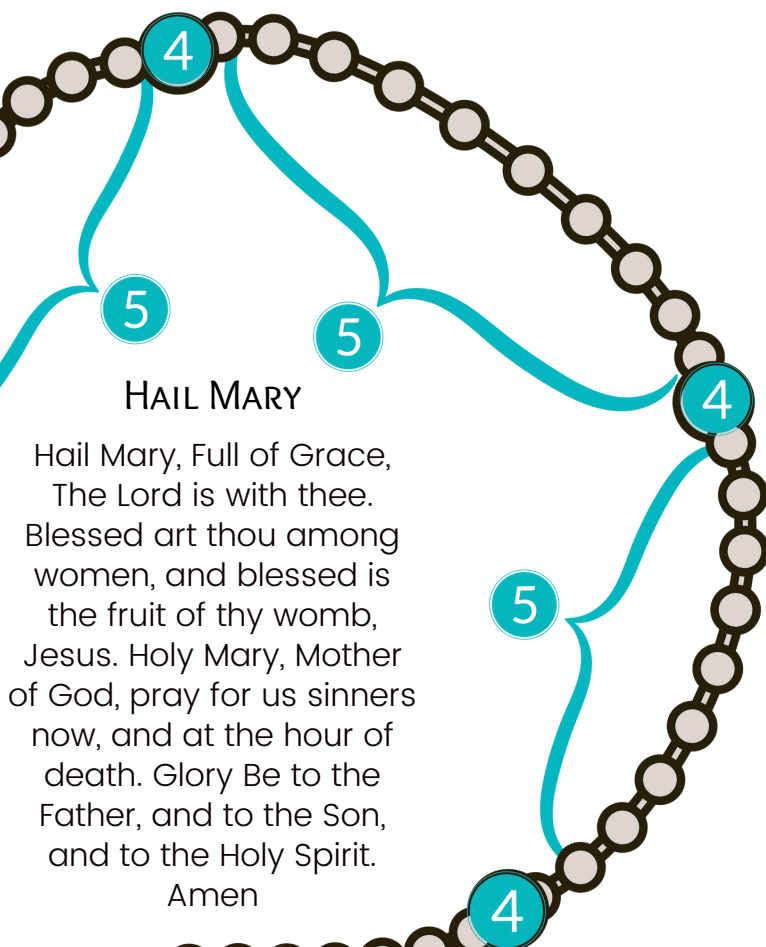
- 1 Our Father

St. Annibale Di Francia (1851-1927) is the patron saint of seminaries and orphans. His father died when he was still a baby and this gave him a desire to help the poor and orphans. Fr Annibale founded the Rogationist Fathers, with the mission to pray for priests, help the poor, and encourage others to pray for vocations. His life was an unceasing prayer to God the Father, the Lord of the harvest. St. John Paul II proclaimed Fr. Di Francia a Blessed on October 7, 1990, and he became a canonized saint on May 16, 2004.
